Creating the flashcards can be fun and rewarding for you and your child. It's a great project to do together, and best of all, if one of the cards get torn or lost, you can print and cut it out again.

These cards are designed to help your child recognize and remember what letters and numbers look like. Each card has a colorful illustration that represents the number or letter on the card.

Your child will begin to recognize the letters and numbers they see on the cards. Help him find the letters in their favorite storybooks. Try counting out other items you see around the house.



Instructions:

Print out the complete set of cards, except for the backing, onto cardstock or heavy paper. Print the back side of the cards by turning the paper over and inserting them back into your printer. (All printers are designed differently. It is very important that you print a test sheet first to make sure that you have your paper facing the right direction.) Cut each card along the dotted lines. Enjoy!
